

Grand Island Board of REALTORS Scholarship Instructions

The Grand Island Board of REALTORS offers one (1) scholarship to a Grand Island graduating high school student. The value of the scholarship is \$500.00.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship award, a student must:

1. Be in the upper half of their graduating class.
2. Possess attributes evidencing potential in their selected vocation.

To Apply

To apply for the scholarship a student must do the following:

1. Complete and submit the Grand Island Board of REALTORS Scholarship Application form.
2. Submit a one page Personal Narrative per the instructions on the application form.
3. Submit an official transcript of high school work.
4. Submit two letters of recommendation from teachers who have taught the applicant.

Letters of application should be mailed directly to the Executive Officer of the Grand Island Board of REALTORS postmarked no later than April 1, 2015. The Board of REALTORS Scholarship Committee may interview qualified applicants.

Terms of Payment

The scholarship is to be used for tuition in a college of choice for the next school term immediately following graduation from high school. Monies will be mailed in July directly to the financial aid/counselor's office of the college stated on the recipient's application. Recipients should notify the Grand Island Board of REALTORS office immediately should choice of college or intentions change.

Applications must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2015 in order to be considered for this scholarship.
