Buffalo-Hall County Corn Growers Scholarship

Guidelines:

1. Applicant must attend a public or private post-secondary institution. The scholarship award will be sent directly to the financial aid office of the institution upon verification of completion of the fall semester and enrollement of the spring semester.
2. Applicant must be majoring in an agriculture related field.
3. Applicant's parent/guardian must be a member of the Buffalo--Hall County Corn Growers. If students want to apply for the scholarship and their parents are not current members, dues in the Nebraska Corn Growers Association are \$90 annually or \$180 for three years. Detailed membership information is available by contacting the state office at 888-267-6479 or www.necga.org.
4. Two scholarships in the amount of \$500 will be awarded.
5. Application must include 2 letters of recommendation. One from within school (administrator, teacher, etc.) and one of personal choice (not a family member.) Letters of recommendation must contain information about leadership, character, initiative, and school/community involvement.
6. Scholarship decisions will be made by the Buffalo-Hall County Corn Growers scholarship committee.
7. Application deadline is April 1, 2014. Complete application forms and letters of recommendation, along with a student transcript should be submitted in one packet to:
